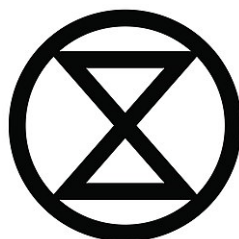


PRAYER VIGIL FOR CLIMATE HEALING

An ecumenical and interfaith prayer vigil

(Near the University Footbridge)



PRAYER VIGIL INFORMATION

We invite people from all faith communities to gather at 5.30pm in the city; either at a place significant for your own faith, or near the plaque at the Sri Chinmoy Peace Park opposite the Women's and Children's Hospital on Sir Edwin Smith Avenue, North Adelaide.

Each community is invited to bring a flask of water, symbolizing our connection with the divine according to our own tradition; and to wear clothes distinctive of our various traditions.

From these places we will walk quietly to meet together at 6pm by the river near the University footbridge, at the landing place near the boat sheds.

There we will observe some silence, be **Welcomed to Country by a Kurna elder**, and join in a circle to pray. There will be a symbolic pouring of water into a single vessel. This will then be poured into the river by the Kurna elder, symbolizing our prayers for healing of our common home. There will be time to reflect together and hear a few words by Dr. Deidre Palmer, president of the Uniting Church.

Afterwards, **we will have a picnic by lamplight.**
